GAP CACHE is an urban treasure hunt! It will take you to six exciting gaps in the inner city where you can play sport, make music, fix your bike, enjoy nature and discover new things about your city.

SOUND GARDEN What sounds can you hear in your city right now? These musical instruments have been created from recycled materials by local artists to help you create your own soundscape. How many different sounds can you create? Can you beat out a rhythm that works with the other sounds you hear around you?

THE COMMONS Where else can you play a sport, a couple of holes of golf, a tune on a piano, and swap a plant all in one place in the city and all for free? Come and check out the markets and other events hosted here. See fb.com/TheCommonsCHCH

RADBikes is a community bike shed where you can come and fix your bike, pimp it up with some new parts or trade in your old bike for a new old bike. A crew of volunteer bike enthusiasts will be there to help you on a Wednesday evening or Sunday afternoon. See fb.com/RADBikes
